Responsibilities:

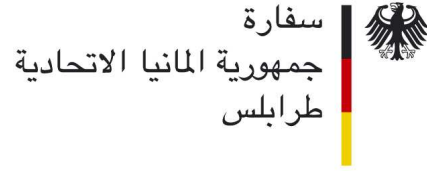
- implement strategic communication campaigns of the German Federal Foreign Office concerning Libya

 - write evaluation reports
 - take part in weekly telephone conferences of the “Interactive Team” and contribute to the constant development and evolution of communication regarding migration and related topics
 - engage with personalized communication on social media platforms from an embassy account in order to correct rumours and fill information needs of current and potential migrants in social media networks
- general communication and other tasks related to migration campaigns
